Functions and Responsibilities

- Assesses, plans, implements and evaluates nursing care to meet the needs of clients in accordance with competency guidelines within the established standards of practice and current legislative scope of practice
- Provides input regarding clients' needs, performance, and progress. Attends multidisciplinary care meetings
- Encourages and assists clients in activities of daily living as required, such as bathing, skin care, oral hygiene, and toileting
- Administers medication to clients and provides medication reminders, in accordance with established policy and procedures
- Observes clients and their environments, and reports unsafe conditions and behavioural, physical and/or cognitive changes to supervisor
- Provides emotional support and feedback to clients and their families
- Completes and maintains related records and documentation such as progress notes, observations, cardex, and client charting. Reports problems and/or changes to designated staff
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
